

Entertainer celebrity Dick Lee organizes charity to help 7000 kids

Local celebrity entertainer Dick Lee has started a charity plan "Sunshine Journey" to help 5 beneficiaries with a total of 7000 children and youths.

With the plan, he hopes that "Sunshine Journey" will be able to raise funds totalling to \$200 to \$300k within one year's time.

Sales of his upcoming book in July: "The Adventures of the Mad Chinaman", and two music albums will also be under this plan.

The 5 beneficiaries included Canossian School and 4 other non-profit organizations. Dick Lee also has plans to start an art education programme for the youths and children under the beneficiaries, including a big scale musical or performance.

Talking about the reason for this charity plan, Dick Lee said "During my school days, I was rebellious kid and my results aren't that good, and I was having problems with my eyesight then. So in a way, I can understand their feelings and the situation they faced. I believe what the children need most is self-confidence and determination for them to realize their potential to the fullest."
